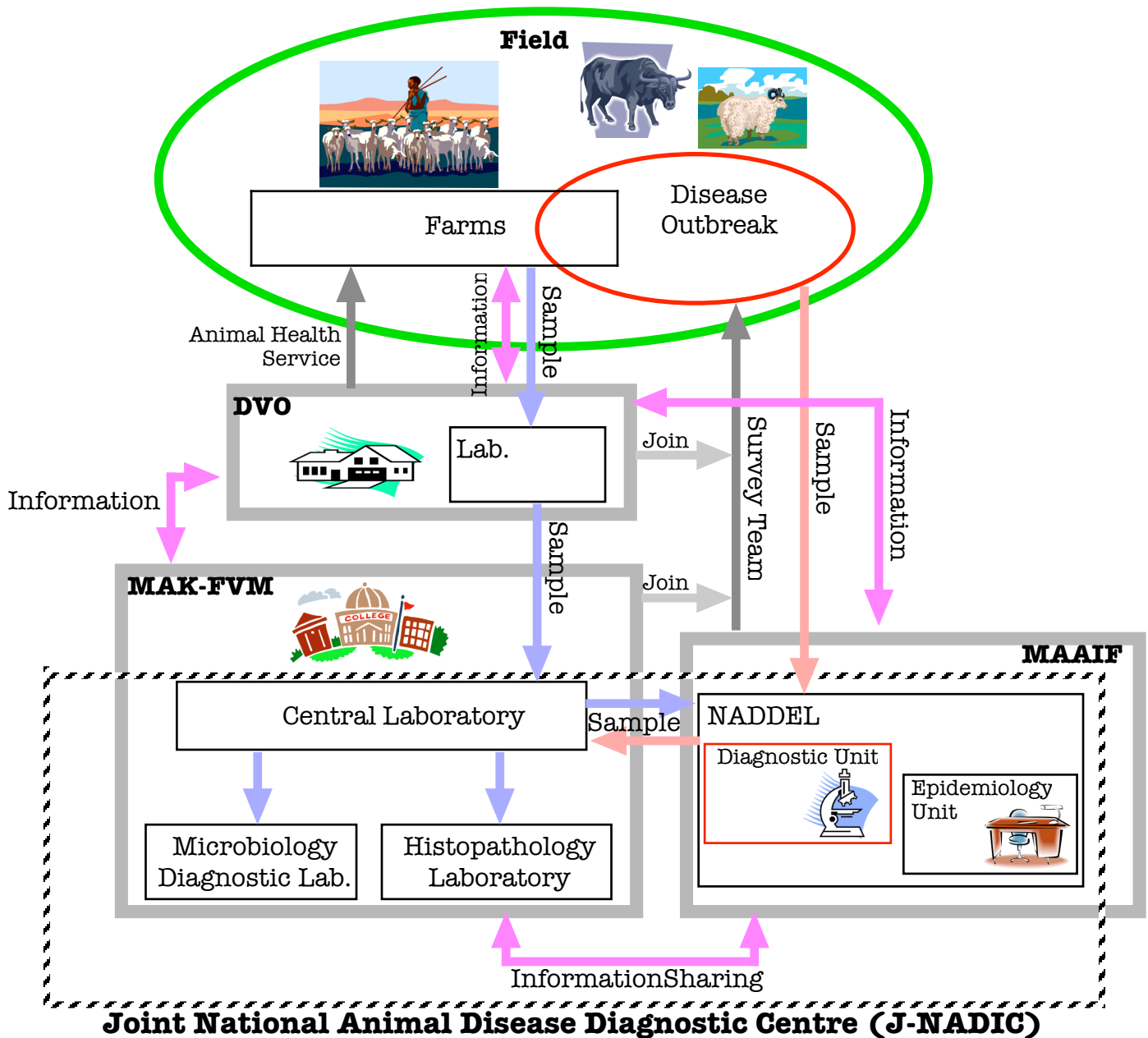


# Sample and Information Flow between the Field and the Joint Animal Disease Diagnostic Centre



## 1. Samples for ordinary disease diagnosis

- i) Samples should be collected by the district officers.
- ii) Samples are sent from DVOs to the Central Lab. in Makerere.
- iii) Diagnoses are made in an appropriate section.
- iv) Results are fed back to the field through DVOs and also shared between MAK-FVM and MAAIF

## 2. In case of emergency disease outbreak

- i) MAAIF organises a survey team.
- ii) The survey team is sent to the focus of the outbreak. Staff of MAK-FVM and DVO might be asked to join the team.
- iii) Samples are collected by the team.
- iv) Those samples are examined in an appropriate section.
- v) The results are utilised for control.
